There was a discussion about pre-selling bulbs on the internet, with Pay-Pal handling the money for a small charge. Lynn Slackman will have to organize everything on the web page. Pam Hardy, Don and Lynn will form a committee, with Kim Peterson as a consultant to study the feasibility.
